A state panel of reviewers for the Instructional Quality Commission recommended to the California State Board of Education the adoption of Benchmark's new research-based elementary CA Common Core State Standards language arts systems. This recommendation is for a non-basal approach to literacy that is built on the California ELA/ELD Framework, CA Common Core State Standards, and new CA ELD Standards. "We listened to California educators who insisted students, teachers, and parents needed a fresh, effective, and efficient tool to implement Common Core for their diverse students that didn't involve a basal approach," said Tom Reycraft, CEO and Owner of Benchmark Education.

California Advance and *Adelante* were built on the California ELA/ELD Framework, ELD Standards, TCA Common Core Standards, and are the first systems in their class to focus on boys and girls with multiple levels of text to engage and challenge them in reading, writing, and learning with their desired interests and creativity in mind.
